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#### RESEARCHER/PROGRAMMER EXPLANATORY NOTES

1) Numbering of new questions: Select a 'series' of question numbers and have all new questions from this wave start with that prefix. For example, questions added at Wave 8 should be numbered Q81XX. The first new question we add will be W8101 etc. If the new question is a follow up to an existing question we can number it with the same suffix or a +1 suffix. For example, if Q2905 is an existing question, then Q8105 or Q8106 would follow it. If Q8105 or Q8106 already exists then we can default to wherever we are in the count that started with Q8101, from questions that do not follow existing questions.

In addition, the question label in the datafile should indicate that the new question follows an existing question even if that is not obvious from the question numbering. We should include a Programming Note (PN) to indicate that. For example, the variable label for Q8106 should read "Q8105: (Q2905 follow-up) How many times in the past 12 months...". We can introduce a note in the datafile documentation that explains the notation.

Finally we should indicate new questions that are introduced in Wave 8 with an additional note in the questionnaire, for example Q8105 (NEW in WAVE 8).

2) **Text inserts in follow-up questions on sexual violence & assault:** At the center of the survey we have a cascade of text insertions. The survey asks respondents to report whether have been the victims or perpetrators of a number of activities. Often these activities are presented together, at time in a grid and at other times in questions that follow one another. Ideally, we would want to have follow up questions about all activities they have been victims or perpetrators, however, given the length, repetitiveness and sensitivity of the questions involved we choose to focus on only one activity. This note aims to clarify how that selection is done to ensure the respondents are displayed the correct text insertion.

The operating principle for the text insertions is that if a respondent was a victim or perpetrator of more than one activity, then the follow up questions should ask about the most severe of those activities. The main place this is applied is in the section on sexual violence (e.g. rape, attempted rape and coercive sex) and sexual assault.

For respondents who experience more than one activity in question, the survey logic should function as follows:

1) If the respondent experienced rape and something else, IF (Q2905/2 AND Q2906/2-4), then the text insert should focus on rape and we do not ask about the other experience. The text insert would read: → 'made to have sex'

2) If the respondent experienced coercive sex and something else, OR ((Q2905/3 AND Q2906/2-4) AND (Q2905/1 AND Q2906/1,5,-998)), then the text insert should focus on coercive sex and we do not ask about the other experience. The text insert would read: → 'gave into sex'

3) If the respondent experienced attempted rape and something else, IF Q2905/1 AND Q2906/2-4, BUT NOT Q2905/2 AND Q2906/2-4, then the text insert should focus on attempted rape and we do not ask about the other experience. The text insert would read: → 'tried to make to have sex'

4) If the respondent experienced only sexual assault and none of the other activities above, IF Q2904/2-4 BUT NOT ANY OF ABOVE, then the text insert will focus on sexual assault rape → ‘someone kissed, touched, or made you do anything sexual when you did not want to’. [Note: This is relevant only in the victimization section. In the perpetration section, sexual assault is asked at the end of the survey and is not part of the cascade of text insertions.]

**\*\*Note:** In this wave for the Q2905 and Q3257 series we introduced separate questions to measure ‘past 12 months’ and ‘since the last survey’. The follow-up questions draw on both of these base questions. For example, Q2908 is based off of both Q2905 (past 12 months question) and Q8905 (since last wave question). The inserts likewise are driven by both of these questions. The same prioritization applies as above, only now it is evaluated across two questions rather than one. For example, If a respondent reports rape at Q2905/2 or Q8905/2 then the text inserted is ‘made’.
